One effect of Global Warming, increased temperatures, is causing the Earth's ice sheets and glaciers to rapidly melt, raising sea levels around the globe.

While sea level probably would not be this high at this particular site, the FutureSeaLevel.org art installation highlights a very definite scenario for other parts of the Bay Area, and other cities around the world.

A conservative estimate for the Bay Area is that there will be a 1-meter increase within the next fifty to one hundred years, flooding areas around San Francisco and Oakland airports, sections of Highways 101 and 80, and parts of San Jose.
